ORANGES

Navel - First orange on the market. With its characteristic round shape and deep orange hue, the easyto-peel navel is one of the most popular varieties worldwide.

Baladi – Small to medium sized seedy fruit. It has a smooth and thin skin, well colored and high juice content.

Valencia – The Valencia orange is a large orange variety with a smooth and pebbled surface and a semi thick fragrant peel that clings loosely to its segmented and barely seeded flesh. Its flesh, when ripe, is supremely sweet, juicy and tender.

MANDARINS & TANGELO

Fremont – Attractive, high quality, early-ripening variety. Medium in size, oblate in form; rind medium-thick and of moderate adherence (easily peelable); surface smooth; color bright reddish-orange. Flesh color deep orange; tender and juicy; flavor rich and sprightly.

Murcott – Attractive, high quality, medium to late ripening variety. Medium in size, firm, oblate to sub globose; shallowly ribbed to conform with segments; both base and apex flattened or slightly depressed. Rind thin, rather tightly adherent and not readily peelable; surface smooth to slightly pebbled; color yellowish-orange at maturity. Flesh orange-colored; tender, very juicy; flavor very rich and sprightly.

Minneola – Medium late in maturity. Fruit large, oblate to obovate; neck usually fairly prominent; seeds comparatively few, with greenish cotyledons. Rind color deep reddish-orange; medium-thin, with smooth, finely pitted surface, and moderately adherent (not loose-skin). Flesh orange-colored; tender, juicy, aromatic; flavor rich and tart.

VEGETABLES



Green Beans – Also known as string beans, or snap beans, are the unripe fruit and protective pods of various cultivars of the common bean. They are listinguished from the many differing varieties of beans primarily grown for their dried seeds in that green beans are harvested and consumed with their enclosing pods, typically before the seeds inside have fully matured. Popular green bean cultivars have been selected especially for the fleshiness, flavor, or sweetness of their pods.

Variety: Paulista – Hama - Valentino

Spring Onions – Also known as green onions, salad onions or onion sticks, are the edible plants of various Allium species, all of which are "onion-like", having hollow grean leaves and lacking a fully developed root bulb.

Snow Peas – The snow pea is a legume, more specifically a variety of pea eaten whole in its pod while still unripe. They are a cultivar group of edible-podded peas that differ from peas in that their pods are round as opposed to flat. The name mangetout can apply both to snow peas and to snap peas.

Prime – Is the earliest Egyptian seedless export variety and was developed by The Volcani institute in Israel. The berries are round and of average size for seedless varieties. Bunches are well filled, without being compact and the variety has a good shelf life. It has a light muscat flavour - a fresh and crispy new season taste.

SugraOne – Medium season variety.

Has bright green, elongated berries, and a subtle sweet muscat flavor with a distinctive crunch. The loose bunches; excellent eating quality and good shelf life have made this one of the world's most popular varieties.

RED SEEDLESS

Flame – Medium season variety. This variety results from the crossing between Thompson Seedless, Cardinal, and other varieties. It displays typical medium-sized, round and deep red, seedless berries. Bunches are medium to large, conical and well filled. The berries have a crisp skin, and firm, crunchy but juicy pulp, with a sweet-tart flavour. It is typically consumed fresh or dried as raisins. Caliber: 16.00 – 20.00 mm Brix: 16.00 – 18.00

Crimson – Late season variety. This variety are bright red, large, cylindrical-oval and seedless. The berries are crisp and firm, oval and seedless with a thick, tough skin, and firm crisp flesh with a neutral flavour. Bunches are medium in

RED SEEDED

Red Globe – This variety is very popular in Asian markets. Bunches are large, conical and well filled. The grapes bear big, pinkish-red, very large (round) plum sized berries containing large seeds. The berries are crisp and crunchy and the flavour is guite delicate with a fleshy pulp.

Caliber: 22.00 – 28.00 mm Brix: 15.00 – 18.00

BLACK SEEDLESS

Autumn Royal – This is a large, dark purple to black, seedless variety developed by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) (in 1996). The berries are oval, firm, and crunchy with good sugar levels.

Caliber: 16.00 – 20.00 mm

Brix: 16.00 – 18.00



STRAWBERRY

Fortuna – Has high early-season yields and good fruit size throughout the main production period. The fruit is a glossy bright to dark red, easy to harvest, and has a smooth appearance. The flavor is acceptable and good under ideal growing conditions. Radiance fruit is firm yet juicy and sports an attractive calyx.

Festival – Is a short day cultivar. Fruit is mostly conic in shape. The external color of a mature fruit is deep red and glossy; internal color is bright red. Festival has a very firm texture and excellent flavor.
